- 1. Meet employers who have hired and are committed to hiring deaf and hard-of-hearing co-ops and graduates.
- 2. The employers coming to the fair are seeking candidates from the following degree levels: Associate, Bachelor, and Master.
- 3. The NTID Job Fair is smaller and more targeted than other career fairs.
- 4. Meet representatives from Fortune 500 companies, top federal agencies, non-profit agencies and more.
- 5. Interact with employment recruiters who are deaf or hard-of-hearing RIT graduates and who know from experience the skill sets of our students and are willing to advise and hire.
- 6. Meet face-to-face with employers who are aware of how to communicate with a deaf or hard-of-hearing job candidate.
- 7. Each employer at the NTID Job Fair will have an assigned interpreter or uses sign language so you can have quality time with the representative.
- 8. Your NTID Employment Advisor can assist you in preparing your resume for the employers that will be attending the NTID Job Fair.
- 9. Learn about businesses first hand and find out what they are looking for as well as learn about career opportunities and current job openings with those companies.
- 10. This is a special educational opportunity that happens once a year for deaf and hard-of-hearing students at RIT. If you have class, ask your professors to excuse you so that you can participate.
