Administrative Support Technology AAS Program Outcome Set

Develop a high degree of technical competence in order to gain entry-level employment in an administrative support position

Demonstrate speed and accuracy in keyboarding skills

Measure: 1) Integrated Document Production [NAST-215] - Ten 5-minute Timed Writings Course level; Direct - Student Artifact

Details/Description:

Acceptable Benchmark: 95% of students will type with speed/accuracy at a net speed of 40+ words per minute with 5 errors or less.

Implementation Plan (timeline): At the end of each semester when Integrated Document Production is offered.

Key/Responsible Personnel: Department Program Coordinator

Findings for 1) Integrated Document Production [NAST-215] - Ten 5-minute Timed Writings

Summary of Findings: 92% of students typed with speed and accuracy at a net speed of 40+ net words per minute with 5 errors or less.

This result does not meet our goal of 95%. However, only one student was unable to complete this course requirement.

Results: Acceptable Benchmark Achievement: Not Met

Recommendations: Determine the reason why students were unable to meet this goal.

Reflections/Notes: Look at achievement in the previous course to determine if students should be required to meet a higher goal than now required.

Choose and apply appropriate computer software to effectively and accurately produce business documents

Measure: 1) Business Graphics [NAST-225] - e-Portfolio Review Course level; Direct - Portfolio

Details/Description:

Acceptable Benchmark: 90% of students will earn an acceptable rating score averaging 80% or higher on e-Portfolio rubric.

Implementation Plan (timeline): At the end of each semester when Business Graphics is offered.

Summary of Findings: 100% of students earned an acceptable rating score averaging 80% or higher on the e-Portfolio Rubric. The student ratings were between 90-95 percent.
