▼ **Measure:** 2a. Final grade reports: NENG-102, NENG-103, NMTH-110

Details/Description:

Acceptable Benchmark: 85% of CARPRP-UND students in Level A reading, writing &/or math will earn a grade of "D" or higher in Level A coursework within 2 semesters. Includes students who withdrew (LOA) or were suspended.

Implementation Plan (timeline): Collected annually since 2004

Key/Responsible Personnel: Program Director

Findings for 2a. Final grade reports: NENG-102, NENG-103, NMTH-110

Summary of Findings: 72% of CARPRP-UND students in Level A reading, writing &/or math earned a grade of "D" or higher in Level A coursework within 2 semesters. The result is 100% of students earning "D" or higher if those who withdrew (LOA) or were suspended are excluded from the data.

Results: Acceptable Benchmark Achievement: Met

Recommendations : It is important to note that these numbers should be reported separately as those who withdrew, LOA, or suspended leave for various reasons (academically weak, do not have major, not ready for college, etc.).

Reflections/Notes : The 2013-2014 data reflects the previous director's perspective of how numbers should be calculated. For clarity, the numbers should be reported separately due to the "benchmark" goals. I have adjusted the 2015-2016 and 2016-

2017 Assessment plan to reflect that difference.
