**ADJUNCT PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT GRANTS**

The Office of the Provost and Faculty Career Development created the Adjunct Professional Development Grant to provide funds for adjunct faculty to be used toward their professional development, such as attending conferences, workshops, meetings or delivering presentations as a means to further their expertise in teaching at RIT.

**ELIGIBILITY**

Adjuncts at RIT may apply for up to \$500 in funding, once per academic year. To be eligible for this funding you must have taught at RIT for at least two semesters and will be continuing as an adjunct instructor at RIT (as verified by department heads).

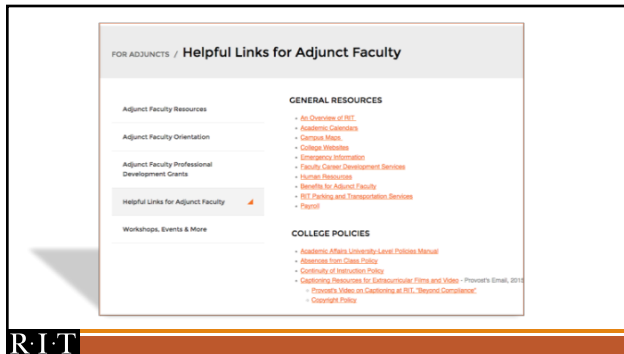
