

DIRECTIONS FROM COPENHAGEN AIRPORT TO MALMÖ CENTRAL STATION BY TRAIN



- The Copenhagen Central Train Station is located in Terminal 3. Take the shuttle bus to terminal 3 (if not there already)
-5 minutes
- The ticket office is located in Terminal 3 above the railway station. There are lifts and travolators between the platforms and Terminal 3. Tickets are available from the DSB ticket office as well as ticket machines in the stationarea.
- Take the train from Copenhagen Central Station to Malmö Central Station. This is also called the Öresund and will cross the Öresund Bridge.

DIRECTIONS FROM MALMÖ AIRPORT TO MALMO CENTRAL STATION BY TRAIN

From the Malmö Central Station it is a 5-minute taxi ride to the hotel or you can walk. See adress, telephone and website above, placed right below the picture

By Foot - 10 minutes:

The distance of around 1 km takes about 10 min to cover on foot.

- Cross the canal on the Petribron bridge and continue straight on along Kalendegatan.
Cross Stora Nygatan and continue straight on along Malmborgsgatan.
- Continue over the canal and cross Drottninggatan.
The hotel is located on the right.

By Taxi - 5 minutes:

There is a taxi rank outside Malmö Central Station. The taxi trip costs around SEK 70 (-\$10 USD).



PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION IN MALMÖ



- RIT Participants will receive a Jojo (a reusable card) for the Malmo City buses good for 72 hours. Everyone should write a starting date on the card and from that date, it is valid for 72 hours (ex. Wednesday morning through Friday evening). You hold the Jojo card in front of a small machine inside the bus every time you travel. **You cannot pay with coins or bills on the bus.**
- The new superbus no. 5 runs from the hotel/inner city to Ubåtshallen/MEDEA. The map below marks "X" where the bus stops are located for bus no 5. It is easy to catch and very near the hotel. It also stops at the Centralstation and runs all the way to Medea, the bus stop where you get off is just opposite to Medea. It's the last stop, called "Ubatshallen".
- You can add money to your Jojo, purchase a single ticket (22 SEK; - \$3 USD), or a 24 or 72 hour ticket (65 SEK or 165 SEK) through any of the following options:
 1. Skånetrafiken customer service centers at either main station in Malmö: Central Station or Gustav Adolf Square
 2. Tourist office at Skeppsbron 2 or at Skånetrafikens customer service centers
 3. Through the Skånetrafiken app for Iphone and Android.

Reminder: You cannot pay with coins or bills on the bus.


Current Conversion Rate of the Swedish Krona 1 USD = 7.09 SEK

ELECTRICITY

Electricity is 220V at 50Hz. Standard European 2 point power plugs, differing from those in the U.S., are used for outlets. Note: Adapters do not convert electricity/voltage they only modify the pins for the electrical outlet. Ensure that your appliances can operate on European 240 volt outlets. You may need a voltage converter if your travel appliance is not dual voltage and be sure to check its wattage.

MEDEX TRAVEL ASSISTANCE INFORMATION



Medex Travel Assistance

RIT provides employees with Emergency Travel Insurance. Please note, this is not a medical insurance. Should you need medical treatment abroad you will have to cover the cost out of pocket and, if the service is covered by Medex, you may apply for a reimbursement. The coverage can also assist with providing travel arrangements in case of a medical or other emergency. Below is the policy information.

RIT Global Delivery Corporation (GDC) offers medical, travel evacuation and repatriation services for GDC employees and their dependents. GDC covers faculty expenses but does not cover Medex fees for your dependents.

If a family member(s) who travels with you on a GDC international assignment becomes ill or disabled and needs immediate medical attention:

1. Call any representative of the partner university whose number is available to you;
2. Partner University representatives have to call Medex at the US. Number: 410 -453-6330, they can call collect;
3. In the condition of emergency, Partner University representative and your dependent should go to the nearest physician

or hospital immediately and then contact MEDEX 24-hour Assistance Center;

4. MEDEX representatives (regional Medical Advisors and Medical directors) will determine the appropriate method, destination and timing of any evacuation. The destination will be the nearest facility capable of providing appropriate care. This destination will also be determined by MEDEX;

5. Medex will have sole discretion in making the coverage determination for your transportation after stabilization. They will NOT return your family member to your home country for convenience reasons.

Medex will NOT cover:

1. Hospital or medical expenses of any kind or nature. Medex is NOT a health insurance policy;
2. Travel arrangements that were neither coordinated by nor approved by MEDEX in advance;
3. If your dependent(s) decides to travel against the advice of a physician or travel for the purpose of obtaining medical treatment;
4. Initial transportation to local facilities, including ground ambulance fees, except as arranged by Medex;
5. Incidental expenses, including but not limited to accommodations, local transportation, meals, telephone, and facsimile charges.
