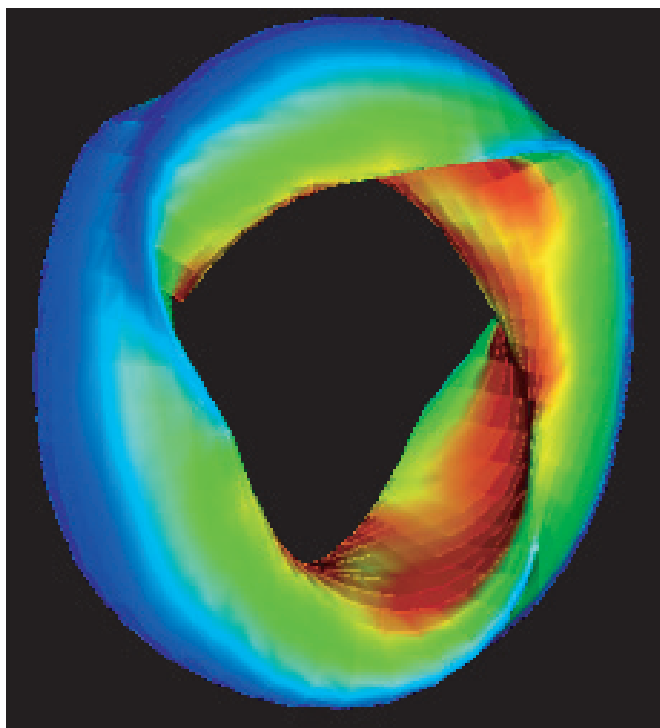


Ten Week Summer Undergraduate Research Program

National Undergraduate Fellowship Program in Plasma Physics and Fusion Energy Sciences



June 7, 2009 to August 14, 2009

The National Undergraduate Fellowship Program in Plasma Physics and Fusion Energy Sciences provides outstanding undergraduates with an opportunity to conduct cutting edge research in plasma science and fusion energy. The summer program consists of a one-week introductory course in plasma physics, held at the Princeton Plasma Physics Laboratory. The research assignment is completed at one of the participating universities or national laboratories throughout the country.

STIPEND

Students will receive a stipend of \$4,800 in addition to transportation to and from their university or permanent U.S. address. Housing costs are covered.

ADMISSION

Applications for the 2009 Program are invited from students in physics, engineering, mathematics, or computer science. The Program is open to undergraduates who are currently in their junior year and are matriculated at a U.S. college or university.
