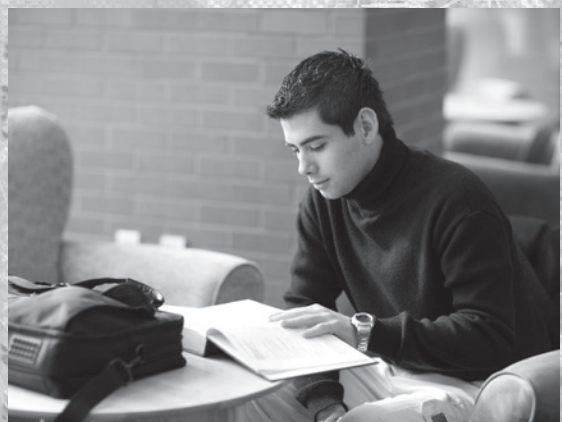

# Graduate Studies Application Instructions

## Admission Requirements

Students applying for admission to the graduate programs must hold, or currently be completing, a bachelor's degree, or the U.S. equivalent granted by an accredited college or university.

Students must meet all appropriate undergraduate prerequisites, and must satisfy standard RIT requirements for academic performance, and should possess a 'B' average (3.0 on a 4.0 scale) in undergraduate studies. Admission decisions will be made by Graduate Admissions Committee at RIT.

Applicants to the engineering programs should have a mechanical, electrical, computer engineering, or related bachelor's degree.

## Official Academic Documents

Students must submit the following academic documents to be considered for admission to the MS degree programs:

Official transcripts of all previous post-secondary education are required. Academic documents must be either original or copies certified by the issuing academic institution. Academic documents must be marked with a seal, stamp, or ink signature of an academic official of the institution. **RIT will not accept photocopies, faxes, notarized copies, scanned copies, or notarial certificates.**

Academic records in a language other than English must be accompanied by an official translation provided by a professional translation service, or by the college/university issuing the academic documents.

## Personal Statement and Résumé

Students must submit a personal statement and résumé as outlined on the application for admission.

## English Language Proficiency

All applicants are required to meet the English language requirement for graduate study at RIT by completing one of the following:

- ◆ Submit an official score from the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) with a score of at least 550 (paper-based) or 213 (computer-based or 80 internet based). For information on the TOEFL, visit [www.ets.org](http://www.ets.org).
- ◆ Submit an official score from the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) exam with a score of at least 6.0 – 7.0. For information on the IELTS exam, visit [www.ielts.org](http://www.ielts.org).

## Graduate Admission Tests

Applicants to the MBA or Finance programs must also submit scores from the Graduate Management Admission Test.
