

BIOSCIENCE EXPLORATION PROGRAM INFORMATION

Overview

Bioscience Exploration is a unique bioscience summer camp experience for students who will be entering grades 6-11 in Fall 2009. Campers will discover how much fun it can be to learn and think creatively about the natural world through observations in the field and experimentation in the laboratory. This camp is a perfect opportunity for youths interested in biology to also learn more about biotechnology, environmental science, microbiology and the medical sciences.

Bioscience Exploration is designed for students who enjoy and perform well in school, and who do not exhibit behavioral concerns that could impact on their ability to participate in an academic program that involves some physical activity in the natural environment.

One-week or two-week options are available for your child to participate in Bioscience Explorers during the months of July and August, 2009. Each session runs from 9 AM to 4 PM, daily, Monday through Friday. An extended day option is available from 8:30 AM to 5 PM for an additional fee.

Camp cost: \$300 per session, 9:00 am – 4:00 pm

Extended Day Option: \$350 per session, 8:30 am – 5:00 pm.

Limited scholarship is available to early registrants this year. Cost includes beverages and healthy snacks. Students are required to bring their own lunches.
