RIT to collaborate on Web-based publishing system

Technology giant Hewlett-Packard Co. has picked Rochester Institute of Technology as one of 34 universities in the world to receive an HP Labs Innovation Research Award.

RIT faculty and students will collaborate with HP Labs, the company's R&D arm, on developing a Web-based publishing system that would take online content from such sources as blogs and wikis and churn out printed documents.

RIT's Open Publishing Lab, in the School of Print Media, is spearheading the research, with College of Imaging Arts and Sciences Associate Dean Frank Cost serving as principal investigator.
