Workshop Description:

Adobe Dreamweaver is a very popular Web site authoring program with innovative features and design capabilities that are useful for beginners and experienced Web designers alike. In this workshop, you will learn basic XHTML (Extensible HyperText Markup Language), the standard language for building Web documents, and Dreamweaver's easy-to-use WYSIWYG (What You See Is What You Get) graphical interface to visually create a Web site.

Topics:

- Understanding basic XHTML code
- Becoming comfortable with the Dreamweaver environment
- Adding/importing text content to the Web site
- Adjusting page and object properties
- Working with links, lists, tables, and images
- Working with predefined CSS layouts, adding and modifying CSS styles
- Working with Spry objects to enhance Web pages
- Working with forms and objects to collect data
- Creating dynamic user interface elements such as rollovers and image maps
- Adding multimedia elements



Prerequisites:

Workshop participants should be generally familiar with personal computers and with Microsoft Windows operating systems. No prior knowledge or use of XHTML or Dreamweaver is required.
