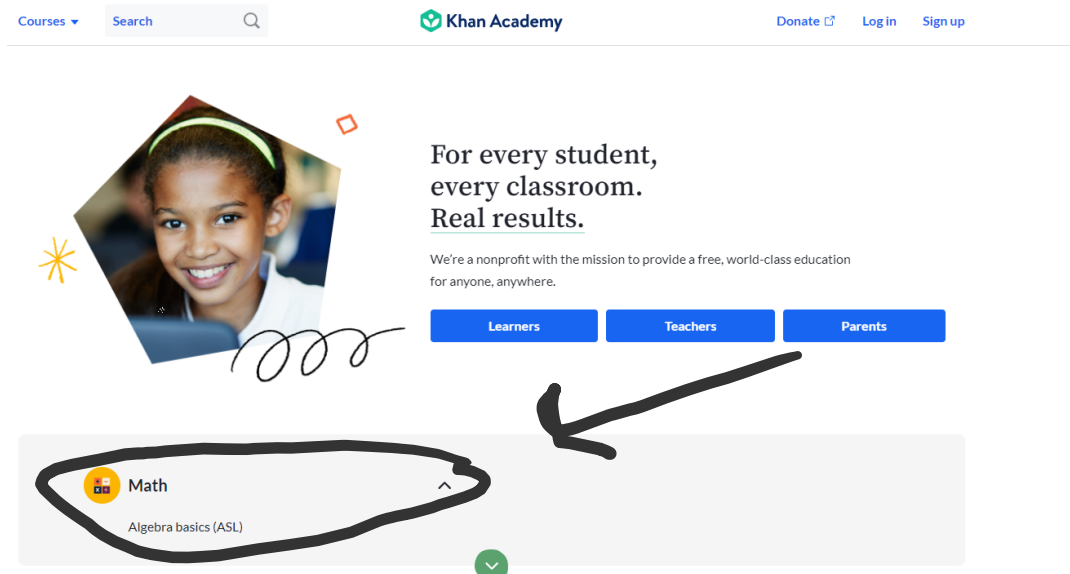
Start with the Khan Academy website:

You should now see Algebra Basics (ASL) as a course

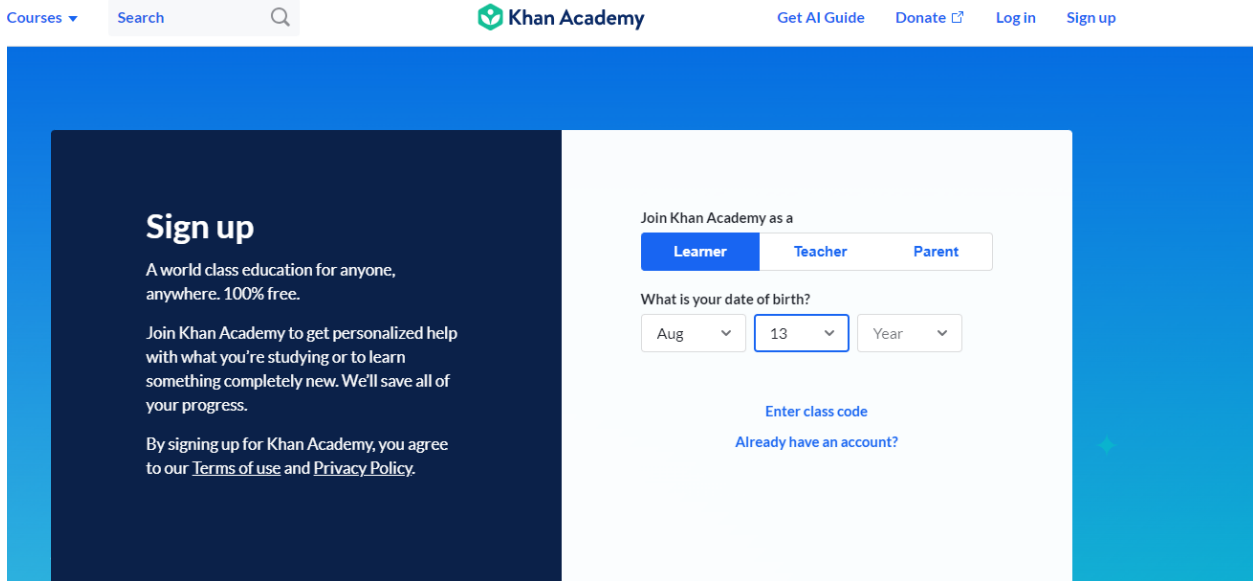


Why Khan Academy works

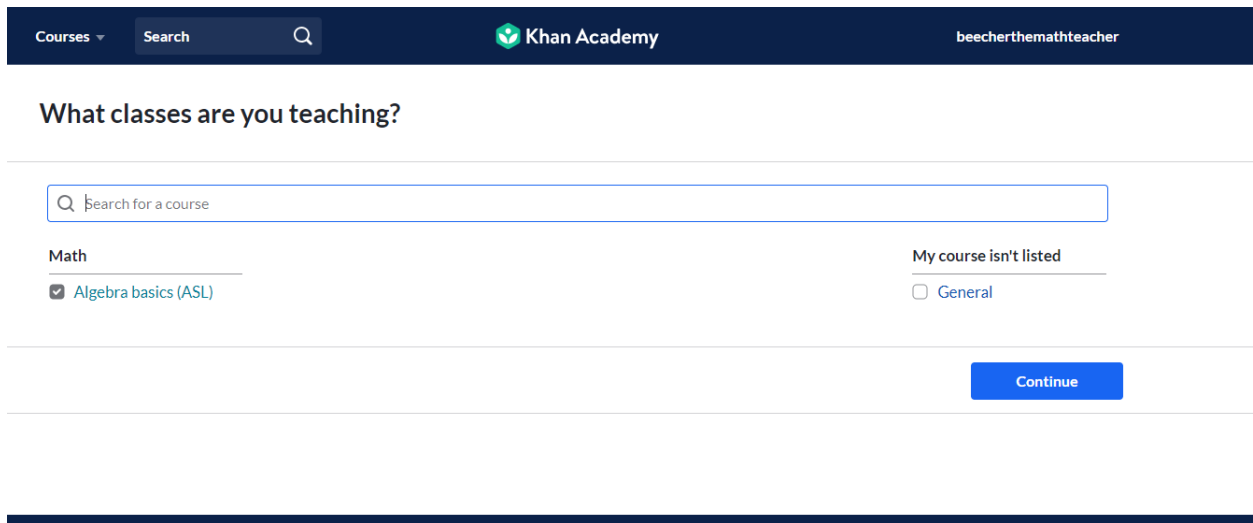
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Create a teacher account

Once you register you can create a class using the Algebra Basics (ASL) course

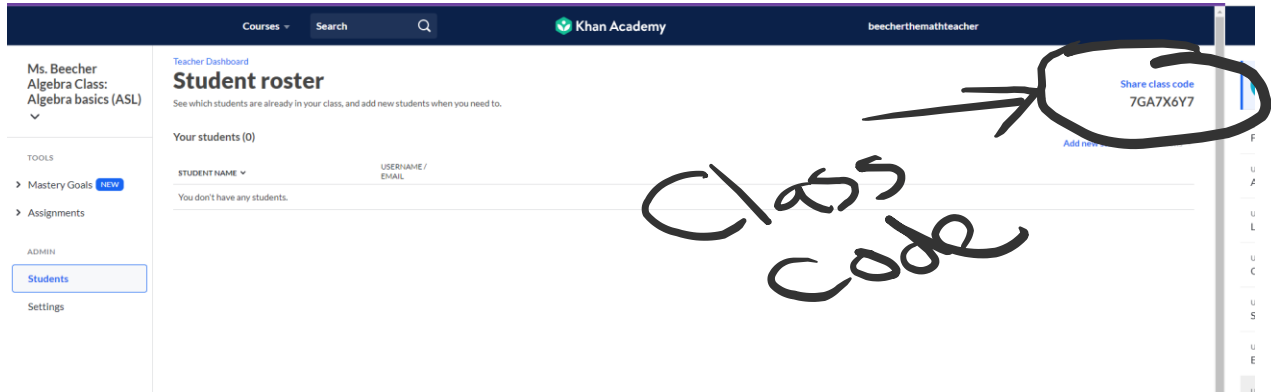


If you do not see this course, go to settings and change the Language to American Sign Language.

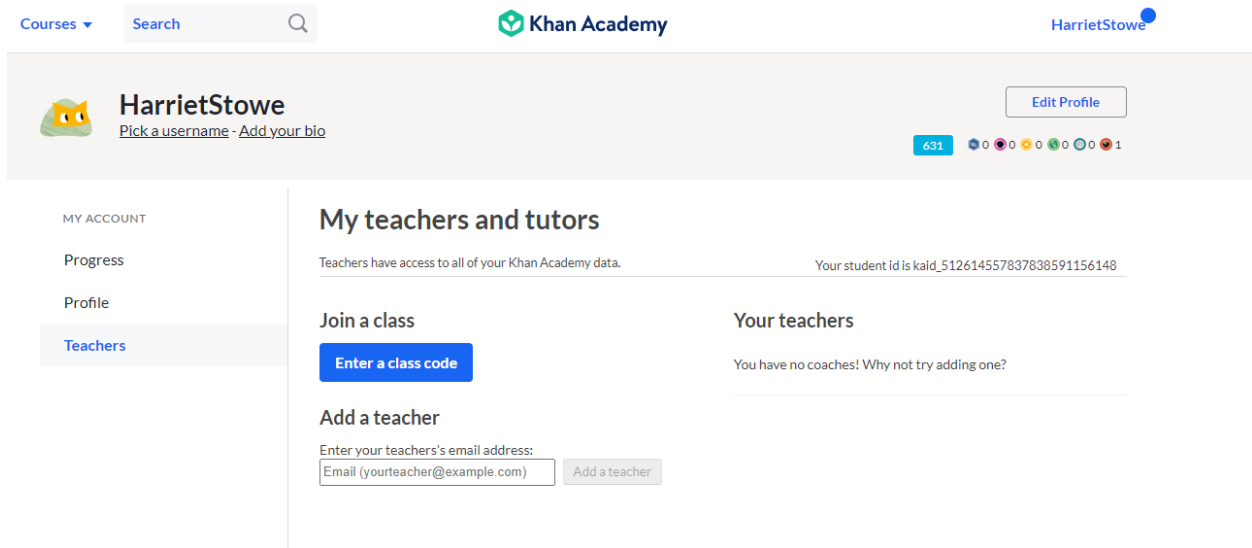
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Dashboard

Once you have created a class, you will see the class dashboard. On the left is the assignments and mastery goals (skill checks). You can view your students in the Admin section. This is where you will find your Class Code.



As a Student, the student creates an account using an email or google account. Students can join via an invite through Google Classroom or they can use the Class Code.



You can assign specific videos, quizzes, or questions to students with specific due dates. As a teacher you can view student progress using the Scores tab on the left under assignments.

Students have access to the entire course even if topics have not been assigned.
