- Contractors and sub-contractors will also be responsible for following <u>NYS</u> <u>Guidelines as of May 14, 2020</u>.

- As with any contractor work related issue, RIT Project Managers or other RIT representative will notify the job supervisor of any observations associated with poor performance, bad practices, safety concerns and now in addition, issues associated with the COVID-19 Guidelines.
- The RIT Project Manager or other RIT representative will notify any contractor or subcontractor and the job supervisor of any exhibited behavior that has the potential of putting the RIT community at risk, and action will need to be taken to stop that activity. This includes behaviors inconsistent with the RIT Visitors and Construction Guidelines.
