



Voting Application Guidelines

Voting Application Usage:

- The voting application (<http://vote.rit.edu>) can be used by SG-recognized clubs, organizations, and other Student Government members to conduct elections, gather feedback from members and constituents, etc.
- An SG-recognized club, organization, or Student Government member may utilize this service two times per quarter.
- The Director of Services will create a “dummy” election and give the representative access to modify and run the election.
- If using a “write-in” ballot, it will be up to the representative’s discretion if any inappropriate votes are to be deleted. Requests to delete write-in votes should be e-mailed to the Director of Services, sgsvcs@rit.edu.
- Any write-in votes deleted by the Director of Services will be logged and viewable by an ITS representative.
- The Director of Services will closely monitor the voting application and all content will be upheld to RIT policies found at <http://www.rit.edu/academicaffairs/policiesmanual/>
