



LEARN TO SKATE at RIT 2009-2010

For skaters ages 3-5 and 6-adults

Our Learn-To-Skate Program is nationally recognized & developed by US Figure Skating. Lessons are held during Public Skate, safely behind a coned off area. Each lesson is 20 minutes long with 2 hours practice time. Classes are offered Saturday or Sunday from 2:30 – 4:30pm (unless otherwise noted). Our program is specialized for both little skaters ages 3-5 *with* their grown-up (Snowplow Sam) and bigger skaters ages 6 to Adult (Basic Skills Level 1-8). It's fun for the whole family!

All of our Learn-To-Skate Participants will receive a US Figure Skating Achievement Certificate and US Figure Skating Level Badge if achieved.

To ensure you get the most out of your lessons with us, we offer an exclusive "Off-Ice Chat" for first time participants and their families. The Off-Ice Chat is held on the **first day of lessons at 1:45pm.** You will meet the instructors who will share their wealth of skating knowledge, including helpful hints, equipment information, & lesson format.

Session Fee: \$72.00 (for 5 week session) includes lesson, 2 hours of practice time and admission to the rink. Rental Skates are *free* the first day of classes! After that, skate rental is available for \$3 per pair. Make-up classes are available within our offered lesson schedule. **Registration Deadline** is the Wednesday before your session begins and is on a "first come" basis.
