Student Employment Eligibility Cards

Planning to work on campus? If so, you will need a Student Employment Eligibility Card. To get one you must be registered for a minimum of 12 credit hours and present the following original and unexpired documentation to the Student Employment Office (SEO):

- Government issued photo ID AND original birth certificate OR original social security card OR
- A current US passport will substitute for all of the above documents

SEO is located in the University Services Center (building 87) room 1350. Open Monday-Friday 8:30a.m.- 4:30p.m. As soon as you have your card, you can start your job search online at rit.edu/seo!

University ID Cards

All RIT students are required to have a University ID (UID) Card. Encoded with your University Identification Number, this card serves as your meal card, Tiger Bucks flexible spending debit card, room key, library card, fitness center access card, and your ticket to RIT campus events. It is also required as identification when requesting personal education information at various campus offices.

- To get your card, bring a photo identifier (driver's license, learner's permit, high school ID, or current passport) to the Registrar's Office.

The office is located on the first floor of the George Eastman Building (building 1, room 1202). Office hours are 8:30a.m.- 4:30p.m., Monday through Friday.

Activate Your Computer Account

Your RIT Computer Account is your passport to RIT online services, including e-mail, the Student Information System (SIS), the myRIT web portal, library databases and much more. Once your account is set up you can:

- Access your housing assignment online (finweb.rit.edu/housing)
- View your student account balance online (ipay.rit.edu)
- Assign eBill access to 3 additional users (ipay.rit.edu/eServices)

Get Your Immunizations

New York State Law and RIT require proof of the following:

- 2 MMR vaccinations (measles, mumps, and rubella)
- 1 Menactra vaccination (meningitis) if under the age of 26.
- Signed acknowledgement of receipt of information on meningococcal disease.

Failure to comply fully will cause you to be dropped from classes and lead to your inability to live in the residence halls or participate in campus activities.
