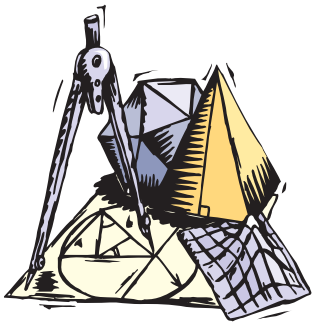

RIT math placement exam

To be placed into the correct sequence of math courses for your degree program, we must confirm that you have a solid foundation in mathematics. In order to assess your mastery of some of the fundamental concepts in algebra, functions, trigonometry, and analytic geometry, you are required to take an on-line Math Placement Exam at <http://placementtest.rit.edu>.

Exam dates:

May 26 - June 6, 2008
(24 hours a day)

Your score on the exam determines whether you will begin your first year taking courses that are required for your program, or whether you will be placed in remedial math courses. This may delay your graduation. For this reason, you should take this exam seriously and take the practice test first. Students who take the practice test are more likely to be placed in the right math course.

Your fall quarter course schedule will not be complete until we have your Math Placement Exam score.
