**ANNOUNCEMENT : H1N1 INFLUENZA VACCINE CLINICS AT THE STUDENT HEALTH CENTER**

RIT Student Health Center has received a limited number of doses of H1N1 vaccine. Currently we have 100 doses of the **injection** formulation to be used for students with medical problems which place them at **high risk** for complications of flu infection. In addition, we now have 200 doses of the **nasal spray** form; this H1N1 vaccine is designated for **healthy adults**, who have no chronic health problems.

The Health Center staff will administer vaccinations to students **under 25 years of age** on 11/17, 11/18 and 11/19 between 8:30 am and 4:30 pm, **starting today** (Tuesday, November 17, 2009) at 2:00pm and continuing as indicated above until **our current supply is gone**.

Please bring your student ID card.

We expect additional deliveries, but the NYS Department of Health has not indicated a date for the next shipment. If you should miss this opportunity, please monitor the RIT and Student Health Center web sites for announcements of additional H1N1 vaccine clinics.
