Publication Requirement Policy¹

PhD in Computing and Information Sciences

Policy Statement

PhD students are required to have at least one highly respected or high-impact publication prior to graduation from the program.

Procedure

- 1. Students and/or advisor will provide written information detailing why the student's publication is considered highly respected or high-impact.
- 2. All material will be submitted to the *Curriculum and Assessment Committee* and the *PhD Director* for review and approval.
- 3. A list of top-tier publishing venues appropriate to the PhD research domain will be maintained by the *Curriculum and Assessment Committee* with input from PhD faculty. A publication that conforms to this list is considered to be highly respected.
- 4. A publication that has a high impact on the field must be supported by objective written evidence to this effect.
- 5. Other publications may be approved with written justification.
