Dessau, Germany

Exchange Program, Spring Semester

The RIT School of Design has partnered with Fachhochschule Anhalt (FHA) in Dessau, Germany to offer junior design majors in Graphic Design, Industrial Design or New Media the opportunity to study in Germany during spring semester. Students take four studio-based courses and live in the charming town of Dessau, about 1 1/2 hours from Berlin by train. Students do not need to be fluent in German.


Florence, Italy

When You Should Go:

The optimal time for College of Design students to study abroad is during the spring semester of their third year. However, work with your academic advisor to determine the best timing for you.

Planning ahead is key! It is suggested to plan one year in advance to ensure proper academic, financial and program application planning.
