- Consider taking minor, immersion or general education credits abroad for more flexibility in program options.



When You Should Go:

Each CAST student and program is unique. Work closely with your academic advisor to determine the timeline that will work best for your program of study.

Study abroad experiences may begin as early as the second semester of your first year, but opportunities to study abroad in your second and third years are also available.

Planning ahead is key. It is suggested to plan between six months to one year in advance to ensure proper academic and financial planning.
