Summer Psychology in Croatia

Explore the rich history and cultural influences of modern psychology on this five week summer program. Take two psychology courses (Abnormal Psychology and Positive Psychology). Courses taught in English.

Learn about the history and politics of the Kosovo conflict of the late 20th century, the dynamic nature of security in the period following the fighting, and continuing challenges to conflict transformation and development. Courses taught in English.

When You Should Go

Economics	2nd year, spring
International & Global Studies	3rd year, fall
Journalism	2nd year, spring
Museum Studies	2nd year, spring
Philosophy	2nd year, spring
Political Science	3rd year, fall
Public Policy	3rd year, fall
Psychology	3rd year, fall
Sociology & Anthropology	3rd year, fall

However, work with your academic advisor to determine the best timing for you.

Scholarships

All College of Liberal Arts majors/double majors receive the COLA Global Opportunity (GO) Grant - an automatic \$500 grant to study abroad.*

RIT Education Abroad Travel Grants (\$500-\$1,000) are available for global campus, faculty-led or exchange programs.

Gilman study abroad scholarship awards funding up to \$5,000. Must be U.S. citizen and receiving Pell grant to be eligible to apply (gilmanscholarship.org)

* Must meet eligibility requirements to study abroad.
