Things To Know:

1. **Access Services.** Support is available as funds allow. Contact Chris Felo at cdfdi@ntid.rit.edu early in your study abroad planning to inquire about availability of access services.
2. **When To Go.** Talk with your academic advisor to determine timing and coursework.
3. **VR Support.** Vocational Rehabilitation (VR) services may provide financial

- assistance to NTID students studying abroad. Talk with your VR counselor to determine if assistance is available.
4. **Tuition.** Students pay NTID tuition for RIT global campus and faculty-led programs. In addition, there is usually a program fee (housing) and out-of-pocket expenses (flight, meals, personal spending).
5. **Funding.** Scholarship opportunities can be found at fellowships.rit.edu.
