- First Time Global Scholar
- Student must agree to participate as a Global Ambassador for the RIT Global Office;**
- Student must agree to organize an info session or activity connected to promote study abroad to their home campus in collaboration with the RIT Global Office;**
- Student must agree to create content for social media to promote the Global Scholar program**
- Student must live in RIT Housing on-campus;
- Student must be in good academic standing with a GPA of 3.4 or higher;
- Undergraduate students only;
- Must have 3rd or 4th year standing at the time of participation.

*Funds can only be applied toward RIT housing, meal plan or other RIT fees.
