- **Learn state-of-the-practice software**, Revit, used by architects, engineers, and interior designers to create 3D building designs.
- Study for three weeks at Malmö University while exploring the **Scandinavian region of Northern Europe** and the city of Malmö which has a wide variety of architecture styles, both old and new.
- Classroom work in Sweden takes place Monday-Thursday - have **weekends free for independent sightseeing and travel**.

COURSE DETAILS

ENGT 518: Global Engineering Experience - REVIT in Sweden

Revit software is commonly used by engineers and architects to design and manage a variety of structures. In this course, you will combine Revit capabilities with Malmö architectural styles to design new buildings. You'll enroll in the class for spring 2022 with travel to Sweden taking place in early summer.

Open to all undergraduate majors (3rd year and above) and graduate majors. No prior Revit software experience required, no pre-requisites.
