

FACULTY-LED STUDY ABROAD PROGRAMS

Student Eligibility

All students participating in faculty-led study abroad must be in good academic standing and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5.

In their study abroad application, students must provide authorization for RIT Global to consult with RIT's Conduct and Conflict Resolution office about any current or past cases. If a current or past conduct violation or issue exists, the office will provide their recommendation for student eligibility and participation in the study abroad program.

Programs may have additional eligibility requirements such as course pre-requisites, class level, etc. and these will be stated in the Compass description. Applications may require portfolios, essays, interviews, letters of recommendation, etc. to further assess a student's eligibility to participate.
