

Academic Requirements

(Prior to 2017-2018)

To graduate from the Honors Program, the candidate must successfully complete all degree program and Honors Program requirements. The Honors Program requirements are:

- √ 12 Points
- √ A minimum GPA of 3.5 by graduation
- ✓ Annual participation in 20 hours of Complementary Learning activities

Honors Program students are reviewed annually during the spring semester for satisfactory progress toward graduation

12 Honors Points can be attained through a combination of the following:

- Honors Courses
- Faculty-sponsored research (up to 9 Honors points).
- Honors Options (Contract Courses)
- Graduate Course (up to 1 course)
- International Experiences (either study abroad or co-op abroad)
- Full-time co-op or internship not required for your major
- Faculty/College-sponsored professional activities
