TEST YOURSELF

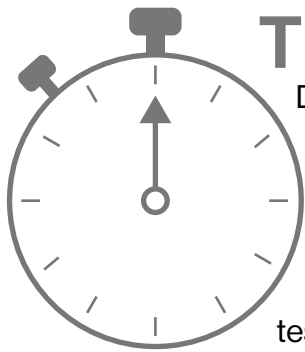
Answer questions you formulated or questions given to you. Test yourself with questions you anticipate to be more difficult than the questions on the exam.
