## I-20 and DS-2019 Forms

U.S. government regulations require you to demonstrate that you have sufficient financial resources to meet the costs of tuition, fees, supplies, and living expenses for at least nine months of full-time study as shown in the table below:

To receive your I-20 (or DS-2019) from RIT, you must submit:

- **Copy of your passport**
- **Bank statement** - Your acceptance letter will show the TOTAL USD you must demonstrate, based on your program (minus scholarship, if you were awarded one).
  - If the funds are not in your name, complete the form on the next page and submit it to [gradinfo@rit.edu](mailto:gradinfo@rit.edu).
- *If you are a **government/agency sponsored student**, you should provide RIT with the financial guarantee from your sponsor.*

Once you have been admitted and your submitted documents have been declared acceptable, RIT will issue you your I-20 (or DS-2019).

*\*Costs are estimates and typically increase each academic year. Personal expenses for travel, entertainment, etc., are not included in the figures above.*
