Advantages of RIT Housing



Options: single to multiple occupancy housing, residence halls, apartment, and suite-style at a range of rent rates



9-Month Contracts: that coincide with the academic year with No Termination fees when leaving for co-op



Utilities: includes high-speed wireless, laundry, furnished and unfurnished options available



Convenience: location with access to dining, academics, and recreational facilities



Transportation: free shuttle service around campus and to local shopping



Safety: safe and secure environment with card swipe access, Public Safety patrols, and on-site Residence Life staff

Applying for Housing

- Graduate students are assigned to RIT housing on a space-available basis. Placement in RIT housing is not guaranteed. Students who are interested should submit their RIT Housing Contract soon after they make their admissions deposit.
- Once your tuition deposit is paid or waived, you will have access to the RIT Housing Contract.

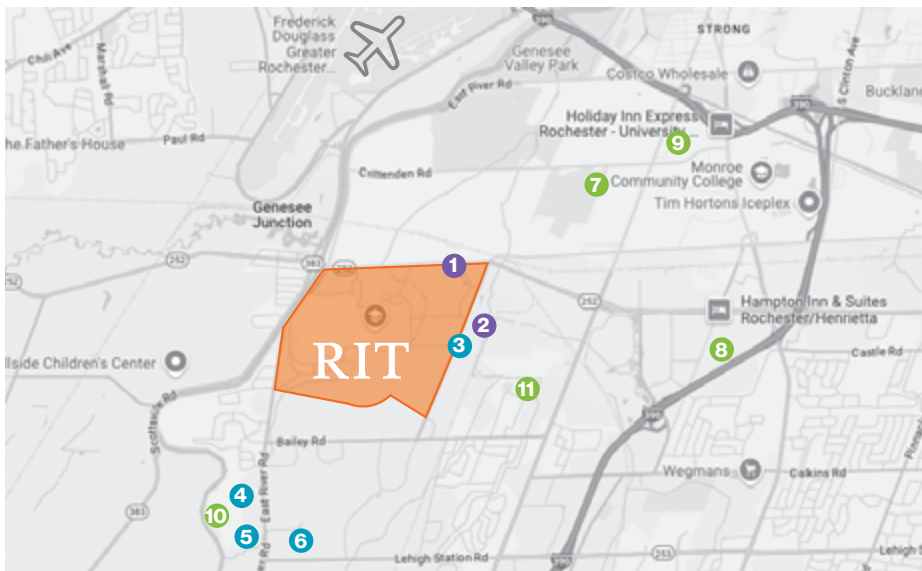
