In addition to co-op placement assistance, the Office of Career Services and Cooperative Education also provides you:

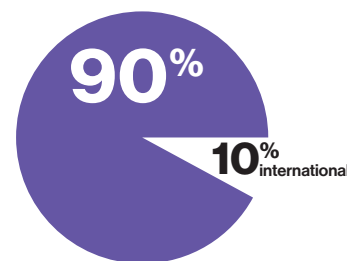
