

Crematory Operation and Maintenance Checklist (November 2022)

Daily Operating Checklist

- ✓ Preheat afterburner and confirm required temperature.
- ✓ Make sure air intake areas are free of obstructions.
- Keep combustibles away from unit.
- Complete cremation certification form required by 219-4.4(e) before charging any remains.
- ✓ NO TRASH.
- Weigh charges and record weight before charging.
- Stay within recommended maximum charge weight.
- Cremate animals with high fat content or highly combustible containers early in the day.
- Let unit cool in between charges.
- Check for opacity/smoke, especially with large charges or those with high fat content.
- Make sure printed daily record shows date and time of each charge.

Routine Maintenance Checklist

Weekly

Clean opacity sensor lens (if equipped) and calibrate equipment.

Monthly

- Clean spark plugs and set gaps.
- Clean flame detectors (if equipped).

Quarterly

- Check primary chamber and refractory for wear.
- Inspect exterior condition of exhaust stack.
- Check the combustion chamber jacket for VISUAL SIGNS of hot spots (be careful!).

Twice yearly

Check condition/clean draft fan.

NOTE: These maintenance checkpoints are provided for your general information, always verify maintenance needs and recommended time schedules with your equipment manufacturer.
