

## **RIT Glass Studio Residency**

RIT Glass is seeking candidates interested in pursuing glass-related research for the 2020-2021 academic year while contributing to the creative community in RIT's Glass program and the College of Art and Design.

The Glass Studio Resident will have a personal studio space and 24/7 access to all glass facilities. Available studio facilities at RIT include a hot shop, flame shop, mold making studio, a wide assortment of kilns, and a coldworking studio. Standard studio materials (hot glass, plaster, silica, wax, etc.) are provided. Crossover with other entities on campus (in the School of Art, School for American Crafts and the university at large) are supported and encouraged.

As a member of the RIT glass community, the resident artist is invited to participate in all aspects of our program's academic activities, including (but not limited to) critiques, visiting artist lectures and demonstrations, presentations, studio visits, technical instruction. We want your involvement, practice and voice to be part of the RIT Glass conversation. The Studio Resident will be awarded a solo exhibition near the end of the Spring term to showcase the culmination of the year's work and research during the Studio Residency.

In return, the Studio Resident will participate in weekly program meetings, regular studio clean-up, and participate in the production and preparation for the program's annual Pumpkin Patch Fundraiser. The awardee of the Glass Studio Residency will be provided an honorarium of \$4,000.00 USD. In addition, the Studio Resident will have a paid teaching opportunity each semester—introductory glass courses to undergraduate students in the studio of your choosing. The Studio Resident will be responsible for their own housing and any specialized materials.
