

General List of Supplies for all art and design majors

Students in the College of Art and Design will find many, if not all, of the following items useful throughout their time in college, and in life in general!

Students in **Illustration, Medical Illustration, Studio Arts, Graphic Design, Industrial Design, Interior Design, Photography, Motion Picture Science** and **Film Production** are encouraged to bring the “required” items to school with them to avoid delays in ordering online, and needing to make shopping trips.

Students in **3DDD, New Media Design, and Animation** will also need many of these items in their freshmen foundation courses.

For health and safety reasons, we recommend you avoid sharing supplies, and consider bringing as many of these basic household items, as possible, to school with you in fall.

Required

1. Basic writing/drawing tools, such as, pens, pencils, highlighters, etc.
2. Ruler- Steel w/ cork backing 18"-24"
3. Hot Glue Gun
4. Super Glue
5. Packing Tape
6. Masking Tape
7. Double Sided Tape
8. Scissors
9. Exacto Knife
10. Utility Knife
11. Needle Nose Pliers
12. Gaffer Tape (SOFA only)
13. 3-hole punch (SOFA only, but recommended for all)

Recommended

1. Tape Measure
2. Multi-tip Screw Driver
3. Allen Wrenches- Metric and Imperial
4. Hammer/Mallet
5. Adjustable Wrench
6. Diagonal Side Cutting Pliers
7. Files
8. Rasps
9. Saws
10. Putty Knife

In addition to the above general items, students in majors within the Schools of Art, American Crafts, and Design* may wish to bring additional items for their foundational courses in drawing, 2-D Design and 3-D Design. Although each professor will have their own personal recommendations, students will be utilizing a variety of basic art supplies as listed in the **2021 Art and Design Kit from Barnes and Noble**. Some students may have a significant amount of the listed supplies, and just need to buy some supplemental materials, while others are starting from scratch and will appreciate the convenience of the pre-packaged kit.
