
University-Wide Footer Disclaimer links

Site-Specific Footer Contact Links

A unique case that is specific to the Contact section of site-specific footers, which only occur on a gray background. Any contact info links, such as email addresses, are treated like inline links, where the link is underlined by default, for added emphasis.



Accordions

Accordions are lists of headers that can be clicked to show or hide content, making it easier to present information in an organized way. Accordions use plus and minus icons to indicate clickability.

Parent accordions use circular plus/minus icons to the right, and child accordions use plus/minus without circle to the left.
