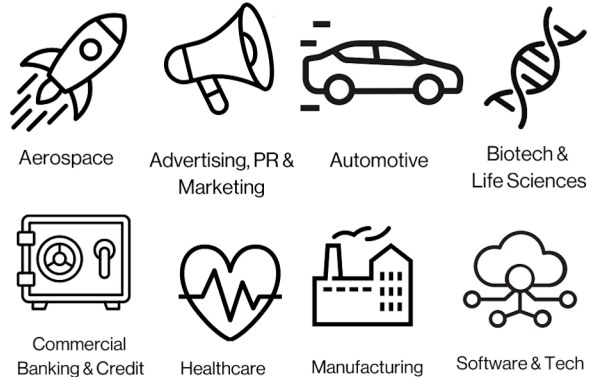

Curriculum+ Experiential Learning

The Executive MBA comprises of 20 core courses and 4 electives totaling 47 credits. The core focus on finance, operations and marketing functions, strategic leadership and innovation. Key experiential learning components of the program include:

- 3-day Orientation on RIT Campus in August (both programs) or January (online only).
- 4-day Business Simulation residency in May (both programs, Fall starts only).
- 10-day International Trip in October to a unique destination exploring business, economic and cultural elements. Past trips included Ecuador, Panama, Taiwan, South Africa and Estonia.
- Capstone consulting project for a company seeking strategic solutions to their real-world issue.

Electives

Students enrolled in the Executive MBA or online EMBA will select one of the following elective groups to complement their professional development goals:



Traditional

Examines executive leadership and global business opportunities from economic, political and social perspectives.



Life Sciences & Entrepreneurship

Explores business, entrepreneurship, and commercialization applied to the life sciences and biotech industries. This selection includes:

- Interdisciplinary electives offered online in partnership with distinguished RIT colleges.
- 1-day virtual entrepreneurship seminar in January.
- 3-day trip to New York City in August to meet established and emerging life sciences leaders.



All-inclusive Tuition

Tuition for the Executive MBA or Online EMBA with traditional electives costs \$78,000, and the Executive MBA or Online EMBA with Life Sciences totals \$81,000.

Billing is divided over 4 terms and includes:

- Course materials obtained and provided by program manager
- iPad + Apple Care coverage
- Applicable Trip fees (airfare, lodging, select meals)
- Dedicated staff and mentors for program + career support
- Access to RIT's virtual and campus services + amenities
- \$1,500 deposit to confirm acceptance.

Scholarships, Employer Sponsored Plans + Aid

Every Executive MBA student is eligible for exclusive program scholarships based on need and qualifications that can be combined with select company sponsored plans, and qualifying discounts.



- 37% of admitted students receive full or partial funding from employers.
- Students who completed previous studies at RIT receive an automatic 20% off tuition.
- Active military and veterans may utilize the applicable GI Bill and Yellow Ribbon benefits.
- Additional scholarships available to students include the Executive MBA Dean's, Community Builder, Zriebic Non-profit, and more!

No GMAT/ GRE required and applicants must have 6+ years working experience.

- Submit 3 letters of recommendation
- Submit Personal Statement + Additional answers for select scholarship application
