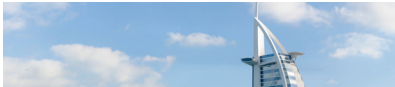

Study business in a vibrant eastern European capital, or hospitality in a medieval destination on the Adriatic sea.

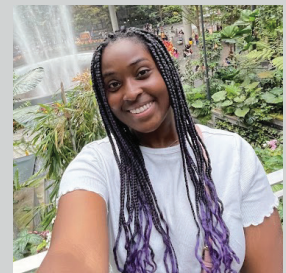

SCHOLARSHIPS & FUNDING

DID YOU KNOW: Your financial aid package can often be applied to your semester abroad. Part of the application process is meeting with the financial aid office to determine exactly how much it will cost for you to study abroad.

- Merit scholarships for study abroad are available through Saunders.
- RIT Education Abroad Travel Grants (\$500-\$1,000) are available for global campus, faculty-led or exchange programs.
- Honors students are eligible for a \$500 travel grant to study abroad.

WHEN YOU SHOULD GO

The optimal (but not only) time for studying abroad is during the 2nd or 3rd year. Contact your advisor as soon as possible.

Planning ahead is key! Plan one year in advance to ensure proper academic, financial, and program application planning.
