

#### COOP Required

- 1 full-time semester **OR** 2 part-time semesters
  - Hospitality students need 2 full time semesters of co-op

#### CO-OP prep course (required)

- SCBI 35- Careers in Business: half-semester
- ACCT 305- Accounting Professions (ACCT majors & Fall ONLY)

#### When will I go on CO-OP?

- Majority of students will go between junior or senior year
  - Must be completed <u>before</u> your last academic term





## 4+1 ACCELERATED MBA

#### DO:

- ✓ Try to achieve a 3.0 GPA in 1<sup>st</sup> year
- ✓ Meet every term/year with advisor

#### **DON'T:**

✓ Worry about waivers (for first year)



#### **FYI**

- Will achieve 4 MBA waivers WITHOUT adding EXTRA classes
  - Need a "B" grade or better
- 4+1 MBA 'official' admission is NOT automatic
  - Need to certain GPA AND 'opt-in' 3<sup>rd</sup> year
  - Work with advisor!
- There's an off-ramp if you do NOT want to continue to MBA



#### **ACADEMIC ADVISING**

Tentative mapping & fundamentals- interests, minors, double-majors, study abroad, etc.



#### Two (2) required meetings BEFORE enrollment

- \* Advisor will send out reminder email to schedule appointment
- \* Meet with advisor whenever needed, not just during 'required' time






## **ADVISOR EXPECTATIONS**

- Respond in a timely manner (during office hours)
- Saunders Student Services Office is open, but...

## **FERPA (Family Education Rights & Privacy Act)**

#### **Student FERPA Rights**

- Begins when student is "in attendance" as defined by RIT
- The right to inspect & review their own education records
- Seek correction of erroneous records
- The right to have control over the disclosure of information from the education records


