Updated Regalia (Cap and Gown) Information

For **Undergraduate** (certificate, associate, bachelor's and **Graduate** (advanced certificate, master's degree candidates):

- There is NO COST for regalia and it is yours to keep!
- You do not have to be measured or place an order.

Ph.D. Candidates: RIT has its own, university specific doctoral regalia. These are available for all eligible Ph.D. candidates to rent for their ceremonies. Orders for this regalia are no longer being accepted. Your doctoral hood is a gift from your academic department and is yours to keep. You will receive your hood from your academic department. All graduates will pick up their regalia on campus at 175 Jefferson Rd. (This is the former Radisson Hotel).

Other Regalia Arrangements:

Undergraduate and Graduate (other than Ph.D.) candidates:

If you will <u>not</u> be in Rochester to pick up your regalia on campus, a friend or relative can pick up your regalia for you. They will need to know the following information:

- Your First Name
- Your Last Name
- Your Height
- Your Approximate Weight
- College you are graduating from (e.g. CET, CLA, GCCIS, etc.)
- If you are graduating with Academic Honors
 - Cum Laude is equal to a cumulative GPA of 3.40 or greater (*)
 - Magna Cum Laude is equal to a cumulative GPA of 3.60 3.79 or greater (**)
 - Summa Cum Laude is equal to a cumulative GPA of 3.80 4.00 or greater (***)
- Type of degree(s) you are receiving:
 - Undergraduate (certificate, associate and/or bachelor's)
 - BS/MS degrees

Graduate (advanced certificate and/or master's degree).

Staff members from Balfour's regalia team will be at every ceremony line up in the

Gordon Field House and the Gene Polisseni Center to supply undergraduates cap

and gown, master's hoods, replace lost tassels, honor cords, etc.

NEW INFO: Regalia "Ship to Your Location" Option:

This option is for graduates who are not planning to attend their ceremony, but

would like to have their regalia.

Your regalia is free, but you will need to pay the shipping fee (\$11.45).

NOTE: The vendor cannot guarantee delivery to your location in time for the

May 12 & 13 ceremonies. If you are attending your graduation ceremony, you

must pick up your regalia during the times stated above.

The order site will close on Sunday, May 7, 2023 at 11:59 p.m. No orders can

be placed after this date.
