## Order Your Cap & Gown (Regalia)

- It's time to start thinking about what you will wear on graduation day. If you were eligible to graduate at the end of the fall semester, and you haven't done so already, you can order your cap and gown right now. Regalia is FREE. All regalia orders are shipped to RIT for you to pick up the week leading up to Commencement Weekend, unless you pay for the Ship-To-Home option (\$14.50 USD).

**A.** No. Tickets are not needed for any of our ceremonies; and there is no limit to the number of guests who can attend. However, for the Academic Convocation on Friday morning, guest seating is limited and will be available on a first-come, first-served basis.
