You can pick up your cap and gown (at 175 Jefferson Road, the former Radisson Hotel) on May 7 and 8, 2024 from 10 a.m. - 6 p.m. each day; and from 11 a.m. - 7 p.m. on Thursday, May 9, 2024. ASL Interpreters will be available for assistance at regalia pick up on all three days from 11 a.m. – 1 p.m. and 4 p.m. - 6 p.m.

* Cap-a-Palooza is free, but you must register in advance due to limited supplies and capacity.


