The grand total of the nation-wide drive was \$6,421.69 on September 19, with a few remittances yet to come,

The Virginia Victory Fund drive reached its climax at the Richmond picnic on September 6th last when its grand total reached \$584.69. The Richmond picnic helped swell the fund with a neat profit of \$72.69, and the great success is due to the wonderful team work displayed by Chairman Meade B. Dalton and his fourteen helpers.

Norfolk's party, under the direction of Glenn O. Coffey on August 29th last, netted a nice profit of \$20.35.

The eighth and final series of the drive netted a sum of \$137.92 which was the largest of the series.
