Required Qualifications:

- Master's degree in MATH/Physics from an accredited university.
- Previous teaching experience at the college level in the Middle East.
- Knowledge of or experience with various laboratory equipment and materials.
- Ability to set up and prepare experiments.
- Ability to teach a wide range of courses in Math and Physics at the undergraduate foundational level including those of laboratory sessions
- Excellent communication skills.
- Ability to work with a culturally diverse student population.
- Proficiency in instructional technology and learning management systems.

- Conduct lecture and laboratory sessions.
- Prepare lecture and pre-laboratory presentations.
- Design, administer and grade assignments and lab reports.
- Prepare and perform experiments.
- Track completion of work assignments and all experiments performed.
- Keep a record of all experiments performed, grades and attendance.
- Report orders for supplies and equipment, while tracking inventory.
