Job Purpose

RIT Dubai is currently seeking applications from exceptional candidates for a teaching faculty position in Psychology for Spring 2026. RIT Dubai is looking for a highly qualified, motivated, and enthusiastic individual. The successful candidate will be expected to teach one or more undergraduate (Bachelor of Science) courses in:

- Introduction to Psychology
- Psychological Disorders
- Personality Psychology
- Biopsychology

Course load will vary depending on qualifications and course enrolment.

The successful candidate will be well-versed in current theories, research and applications within the relevant fields. The successful candidate will be expected to follow course outlines, develop all teaching and learning materials as well as assessments for each of their assigned courses.

Required Qualifications:

For Introduction to Psychology only:

- Master of Science in Psychology or related
- Previous teaching experience in higher education

For all other courses in addition:

- PhD in Psychology or similar (e.g. PsyD) (near completion with previous teaching experience will be considered)
- Previous teaching experience in higher education
- Ability to teach across various courses

Desirable:

- Research experience and recent publications
- Industry experience relevant to the above course offering(s)

- Subject Line: Clearly state your name and the position you are applying for (e.g., Dr. John Smith - Psychology).

- Resume or CV;
- Teaching philosophy statement;
- Cover letter detailing your technical/professional, teaching, and scholarship qualifications and achievements, how these address the required and preferred qualifications for the position, and which course/s of the list you intend to teach; and
- Names, addresses and phone numbers of three references.
- Candidates are also required to send a 2-minute introduction video as part of their initial application. The video can be recorded from their phone and/or Zoom/Teams. This video must be sent via email and/or via WeTransfer (with the same subject line as the application email). The requirements are as follows:
 - Video length must not exceed 2 minutes
 - Candidate is required to introduce himself/herself including: relevant qualifications and professional experience as it relates to the role
 - Candidate must state the courses from above that he/she has previously taught
 - Candidate may include any other information related to their motivation in applying for the role
