Experience & Qualifications:

Assistant Professor

The successful full-time Assistant Professor candidate will be expected to hold a terminal degree in the field of Psychology, Neuroscience or similar, will have previous teaching experience at the undergraduate and/or graduate levels and will have a strong demonstrated track record in scholarship and research with success in acquiring funding. The candidate will be expected to teach multiple courses in the Bachelor of Science in Psychology program including the following breadth courses, and either the clinical track courses or biopsychology track courses

Lecturer

The successful full-time Lecturer candidate will be expected to hold a Master of Science degree at a minimum in the field of Psychology, Neuroscience or similar and will have previous teaching experience at the undergraduate and/or graduate levels. The candidate will be expected to teach multiple breadth courses in the Bachelor of Science in Psychology program

Adjuncts/Visiting Faculty (Part time)

Minimum 3 years teaching and research experience at same rank and/or substantial industry experience. Might be currently working in other universities or in industry.

- MSc in Psychology, Neuroscience or similar
- Previous teaching experience in higher education
- Ability to teach across various courses

Application Procedure

Email your application to careersdubai@rit.edu with the email subject line including your name and the position you are applying for. Submit the following items as part of your application:

- Resume or CV;
- Teaching philosophy statement;
- Cover letter detailing your technical/professional, teaching, and scholarship qualifications and achievements, how these address the required and preferred qualifications for the position, and which course/s of the list you intend to teach; and
- Names, addresses and phone numbers of three references.
- Candidates are also required to send a 2-minute introduction video as part of their initial application. The video can be recorded from their phone and/or Zoom/Teams. This video must be sent via email and/or via WeTransfer (with the same subject line as the application email). The requirements are as follows:
 - Video length must not exceed 2 minutes



- Candidate is required to introduce himself/herself including: relevant qualifications and professional experience as it relates to the role
- Specify which role in Psychology you are applying for (Lecturer, Assistant Professor, Adjunct/Visiting)
- Candidate must state the courses from above that he/she has previously taught
- Candidate may include any other information related to their motivation in applying for the role
