The successful candidate will be responsible for delivering engaging and culturally sensitive instruction in Art History, with a focus on courses such as ARTH-135 (General Art History: Ancient to Medieval), ARTH-136 (General Art History: Medieval to Renaissance), ARTH-368, and ARTH-369 (20th Century Art), Islamic Art and Architecture, and related.

- Deliver high-quality and innovative teaching at undergraduate and postgraduate levels.

- Prepare teaching-related reports (course files) in a timely and accurate manner.

- A Personal Portfolio (PDF or link) with 5 to 10 examples of professional work
- A Teaching Portfolio (PDF or link) with 5 to 10 examples of student work
- A sample of a course syllabus previously taught, with at least three assignments or project briefs.
- A Referees list with Contact information, Names, Addresses and Phone numbers of minimum three (3) references.
