Job Purpose

RIT Dubai is currently seeking applications from exceptional candidates for a lecturer position in Psychology for a Fall 2026 or (maximum) Spring 2027 start. RIT Dubai is looking for a highly qualified, motivated, and enthusiastic individual.

The successful full-time Lecturer candidate will be expected to hold a Master of Science degree at a minimum in the field of Psychology, Neuroscience or similar and have previous teaching experience at the undergraduate and/or graduate levels. The candidate will be expected to teach multiple breadth courses in the Bachelor of Science in Psychology program (listed below):

Breadth courses (all applicants must demonstrate the ability and willingness to teach some combination of these courses):

- Introduction to Psychology
- Personality Psychology
- Health Psychology
- Industrial/Organizational Psychology
- Positive Psychology
- Social Psychology

Pre-track courses (beneficial to have the ability and willingness to teach any of these)

- Biopsychology (Biopsychology Track)
- Psychological Disorders (Clinical Psychology Track)

The successful candidate will be well-versed in current theories, research and applications within the relevant fields. The successful candidate will be expected to follow course outlines, develop all teaching and learning materials as well as assessments for each of their assigned courses.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

- MSc in Psychology, Neuroscience or similar
- Previous teaching experience in higher education
- Ability to teach across various courses

APPLICATION PROCESS:

Email your application to careersdubai@rit.edu with the email subject line including your name and the position you are applying for. Submit the following items as part of your application:

- Resume or CV;
- Teaching philosophy statement;
- Cover letter detailing your technical/professional, teaching, and scholarship qualifications and achievements, how these address the required and preferred qualifications for the position, and which course/s of the list you intend to teach; and

- Names, addresses and phone numbers of three references.
- Candidates are also required to send a 2-minute introduction video as part of their initial application. The video can be recorded from their phone and/or Zoom/Teams. This video must be sent via email and/or via WeTransfer (with the same subject line as the application email). The requirements are as follows:
 - Video length must not exceed 2 minutes
 - Candidate is required to introduce himself/herself including: relevant qualifications and professional experience as it relates to the role
 - Candidate must state the courses from above that he/she has previously taught
 - Candidate may include any other information related to their motivation in applying for the role

Applications review will begin immediately and continue until a suitable candidate is selected. Due to the anticipated high volume of applications it may not be possible to reply to each application.
