## IBC Meeting Minutes 3/4/2024

The committee had one project registration to review from Crista Wadsworth.

Crista: Neisseriasp.; human-associated bacterial sampling

Registration changes needed:

- 1. Add bloodborne pathogen training as a requirement for anyone handling the saliva samples.
- 2. B.1.a Biosafety level says BSL1, but using BSL2 practices. References to BSL1 should be removed. They need to be treated as BSL2.
- 3. References to 1% sodium hypochlorite need to be corrected to 10%.
  - a. Reminder that any bleach solution needs to be remade periodically as its potency diminishes over time.
  - b. Any solution being disinfected needs to be 10% sodium hypochlorite by volume. (Adding a 10% solution to a liter of sample is not adequate.)

## General questions:

- 1. If a participant declines the demographic questionnaire, will they still be allowed to participate? Yes.
- 2. If a pathogenic specimen is identified in a sample, will the donor be informed? Yes.
  - a. This project will require human subjects approval. Ensure that wording is included indicating that subjects will be informed and are responsible for seeking treatment.
- 3. How will the study be made anonymous?
  - a. Crista will maintain the only key linking the subject identities to the samples using sample IDs.

Cindy will schedule a lab review with Elle to verify postings and documentation are in place. The lab is already certified as BSL2.

## SOP changes needed:

1. None

## Training requirements:
