**** Mac Users:**

Need to setup a virtual machine. Virtual Box is free, download that from www.virtualbox.org

Obtain a copy of Windows through the RIT Microsoft Azure portal <https://aka.ms/devtoolsforteaching> get the one that is called “Windows 10 Version 1809 (Updated Sept 2018)” Make sure to view your product key and copy it to a safe location. Download the file.

Once you have your VM setup, run updates and install software within the Windows VM as required.
