Automatically assigned when charges are issued		
Receives all case materials directly from RIT	X	X
Helps party prepare for and process outcome of hearing	X	X
Can provide quiet counsel for the party at hearing	X	X
Can participate actively at hearing only during Cross Examination	X	X
Can be a parent, attorney, or other non-RIT member		X
Can accompany party to appointment to listen to recording of original hearing (if preparing for an appeal)	X	X
