Advocates/Advisor of Choice: Similarities and Differences Advisor of Choice RIT Title IX Advocate Automatically assigned when charges are issued Receives all case materials directly from RIT Χ Χ Helps party prepare for and process outcome of Χ Χ hearing Can provide quiet counsel for the party at hearing Χ Χ Can participate actively at hearing only during Χ **Cross Examination** Χ Can be a parent, attorney, or other non-RIT Χ member Can accompany party to appointment to listen to Χ Χ recording of original hearing (if preparing for an appeal)
